#### **Complete that form**

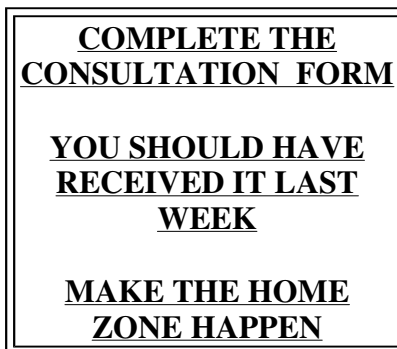
The Council wants to know what you think.

It cannot alter parking, traffic flows, street designs unless we all say '**This is what we want**'.

The Council is also asking people in the surrounding streets what they think about the Home Zone plans.

If they oppose the plans in sufficient numbers because of fears about extra traffic in St Leonards Rd or Drayton Bridge Rd they may prevent the Home Zone from happening.

It is vital that people in the five roads say what they want.

### **What about Parking?**

A Controlled Parking Zone is on the cards for West and Central Ealing which will give a fairer chance to residents and people wishing to park for short periods. More info soon.

The controlled parking zone will be implemented after the Home Zone initiatives described in the consultation document.

### **Why can't we have regulated parking at the same time?**

The council will not introduce controlled parking in the five roads ahead of the rest of West Ealing.

### **When are we going to see something?**

Once consultation is complete the Council will consider all the responses and if people are behind the scheme the go ahead will be given for work to start early next year. All being well the contractors should start in January 2001.

### **Street Party**

Were you there on September 10<sup>th</sup> when over one hundred people from the five roads enjoyed a party in Broughton Rd. The traffic stopped, the jazz band played, the children competed, nails and faces were painted. Half a dozen barbecues cooked meats kindly supplied by Waitrose and everyone had a good time.
