The Five Roads Forum is holding a meeting on Saturday December 2 at the Conservat Broughton Road at 10am. We will be providing an update on Home Zone progress and fill vacancies on the committee. There will also be mince pies and mulled wine.

#### **Consultation**

Ealing Transport Planning department is collating the replies it received to the Home Zone consultation document that was circulated to a thousand households in and outside the five roads. Early indications show a 40% response from FRF households with  $\frac{3}{4}$  being in favour.

Once all the replies have been analysed they will be presented to the January Area Committee Meeting (held at the town hall on January 10 at 7pm) which will decide if the Home Zone should go ahead. There will doubtless be some people at the meeting who think it should not, so why not come along and participate in
