Open Day will answer your questions about shared surface

The Council's Transport Planning Department is holding an Open Day on Tuesday 10th December at the Conservative Offices, 39 Broughton Road.

From 2pm to 4pm and from 6:30pm to 8:30pm you can drop in to meet Evan Bates (our new co-ordinator at Ealing Council Transport Planning Department, he replaced Rachel Felton who has returned to New Zealand) who will explain what the next phase in Home Zone is.

This phase will include:

- Increased car parking
- Shared surface (the road level will be raised to that of the pavement to give a more pedestrianised feel)
- More corner and junction treatments
- More plants and trees

This will be an excellent opportunity to:

- Find out what is proposed
- Ask questions
- Understand how it will look
- Allay fears
