CONSTRUCTION STARTS

On Monday 3rd March resurfacing of roads and pavements

The final phase of the Home zone will commence on Monday 3rd March in Denmark Road and Arden Road. The council intend to resurface most of the roads and pavements within the next five weeks. During this time there will be some disturbance to our normal patterns. Cars will need to be moved, firstly as kerb and drainage points are realigned, and secondly as the resurfacing of pavements and then roads takes place. Letters from council will advise you of specific road closures for construction.

We will help the council inform you of the exact dates when cars need to be moved. If you have off street parking and can help a neighbour at this time – please do! Although it is not close by for everyone, there is usually parking available in St Leonard's Road. Your CPZ permit is valid during operational hours in this road. If cars are not removed the council will move them!

There will also be times when machines are working that are going to be very noisy. We hope you will appreciate the end result: a much better living environment will be worth the disturbance. Some parts of the plan have been redrawn in the light of further suggestions from residents. A copy of the final plan can be viewed on the notice board in Denmark Road. A construction programme will be put up as soon as it becomes available as well. Council will endeavour to keep changes to a minimum but if any changes are made a new construction programme will be put up as soon as possible.

Details of construction works and dates

Work will start in the Denmark / Arden Road section and an initial five day road closure is programmed - no vehicle access will be available during this time. This is the first Home Zone section to be constructed and it is hoped that a single five day closure will be sufficient to enable works and it will be a good guide for duration of works in the other sections.

Pedestrian access will be maintained for residents (and visitors as appropriate) only. Disabled access will effectively be maintained – please let construction personnel on site know of your particular disabled access requirements and they will endeavour to make things as easy as possible for you. It is proposed to do a section of the Home Zone each week and you will be advised of construction works by a letter from the Council. Signs will be placed to indicate extents of each road closure for construction of each section.
