# **Support it or lose it**

The barrier at the west end of Hastings Road is coming to the end of its trial period and the Council will shortly be consulting residents AND THOSE WHO LIVE OUTSIDE THE FIVE ROADS whether it will stay. They'll also be asking about the CPZ hours. It seems likely that those who live outside the five roads will oppose the barrier's retention, so it's very important that residents in the street **return the consultation form** strongly supporting the gate if they wish to keep it. In addition you can write to Councillor Sears at Perceval House expressing your views.

There has been a lot of discussion in consultation groups about the proposed tram link along the Uxbridge Road.

‘Save Ealing Streets’ has mounted a campaign to ensure that the tram does not cause the Uxbridge Road to be shut to traffic in Ealing Broadway and West Ealing, among other places.

At present a number of closures are planned to give the tram dedicated road space.

### **London City Car Club London City Car Club**

Imagine only paying for your car when you’re actually using

it. Imagine someone else paying for it when you’re not. Imagine someone else paying the Road Tax, MOT, maintenance, cleaning, depreciation, the list goes on.

The London City Car Club is looking to start a club in the five roads and has already had quite a bit of interest shown. Members (£12 a month – able to cancel after three months) will be able to book cars for their own use at £2.30 per hour and at short notice. There’s no going to get keys, no paperwork, just book and go. The cars will be permanently stationed in the five roads. The more people that join up the more cars that will be available. It’s being sponsored by the Council and Transport for London.

In Edinburgh there are 200 members and 16 cars. It’s a bit like car hire only much more local, cheaper and easier.
