

FIVE ROADS HELPS FIX LIDO JUNCTION

For some time now, the Five Roads have been working with several other residents' associations on how to improve pedestrian safety at the Lido Junction (Uxbridge Road and Northfield/Drayton Bridge Road). Earlier in the year, the working group met with senior politicians and Council transport officers to submit our written proposals, and the Council have now hired an outside consultant to make recommendations which we hope to see within the next few months. Part of the remedial work to improve this junction has already begun, which involves moving bus lanes and bus stops further back from the Lido Junction on all four sides. Transport for London has committed a significant amount of money to Ealing for this and other major transport improvement projects. We are told that major work on the junction will commence by spring 2011, and feel this is a huge step forward to improving it for pedestrians. The Council's outside consultant is also looking at ways to improve traffic flow down other nearby roads, including St Leonard's Road.

Participate in the Neighbourhood Watch Scheme

Would you like to ensure you and your family are safe in your home? Then get involved in the local Five Roads Neighbourhood Watch scheme! The local Police Safer Neighbourhoods Team will be dropping a letter through your doors in the next few days letting you know about it, and will be asking for people to sign up. They will also have a stall at our Street Party on the 13th of June to tell you more about it. The Safer Neighbourhood Team is a crucial part of policing in the Borough — they give advice on making your property unattractive to burglars, help with non-emergency problems and a load more.

Update on Five Roads Planning Issues

- We are still waiting to hear about plans to relocate the Mattock Lane Clinic into the former Daniel's site, particularly in light of the recent changes in government and NHS funding. We will continue to keep you informed.
- There is a planning application in process on Hartington Road to build a 5-storey block of flats to replace existing garages. We are making written objections to the plans on the grounds of site overdevelopment.
- A planning application for a 2-storey house in the 'alley' in Denmark Road was approved last year, but a second application to increase that to 3-storey was recently denied. No work has started.
- The derelict garage on Denmark Road has been replaced (almost overnight!) with a bright new model, following planning approval.

DID YOU KNOW :

Broughton Road's houses are numbered differently to the rest of the Five Roads. Instead of having odd numbers on one side and odd on the other, they are numbered the old fashioned way — consecutively up one side of the road then down the other!
